
And now, Deraps' second Album "Viva Rock N' Roll" is receiving rave reviews from all around the world:

According to the cliché, second albums can be tough. Not for Deraps, though, judging by the sound of Viva Rock N' Roll. Guitar sensation Jacob Deraps returns with a fistful of tunes that it's very tempting to describe as "sizzling," and "incendiary" - so we won't resist.

Built on Deraps' reputation as a six-stringer in the style of Eddie Van Halen, there's not much deviation second time around either, as that classic high-gain sound stamps itself all across these 11 tracks, although *Equinox* is actually a tasteful intro to *Last Fall*, which feels a bit like *Dance the Night Away with a whisker of White Lion*.

Songs like *The Legend of Larrikin Laddie*, *Blindside* and *Born to Die* don't rely so much on DLR-era VH, otherwise fans of Eddie can plug in pretty much anywhere, as that infectious abandon and joyous swing is in the driving seat from beginning to end."



Another Rock Album Of The Year Contender? Deraps Drop A Cracker...

What a sass bucket of rapscallions, rambunctious Rock. Aerosmith, Van Halen, even a tough of AC/DC; heady stuff...



Wanneer ben je begonnen met het maken van muziek?

"Op een serieuze manier zo'n elf, twaalf jaar geleden. Ik kom uit een heel muzikale omgeving. Mijn moeder speelde sax, piano en bas en mijn vader gitaar. Ik drumde al toen ik vier jaar was, maar toen ik vervolgens op Guitar Hero al m'n favoriete nummers voorbij zag komen van Van Halen, Ozzy, en Toto wist ik dat ik gitaar wilde spelen.'

Je hebt de jaren 70 en 80 niet meegemaakt, want je bent pas in 1997 geboren. Vanwaar dan toch de fascinatie voor de muziek uit juist die tiid?

"Ik ben ermee opgegroeid, ik hoorde het thuis altijd. Er stond bij ons altijd muziek aan. Maar muziek uit latere periodes kan ik ook waarderen, zoals bijvoorbeeld Green Day. Ik luisterde eigenlijk naar alles en nam het in me op als een spons. Later ging ik naspelen wat ik leuk vond, zoals Van Halen, Metallica en nog veel meer.'

Wilde je professioneel muzikant worden?

"Ik heb daar nooit bewust over nagedacht. Ik zat op de middelbare school en voelde me niet op m'n plaats. Ik paste er niet, had continu problemen met autoriteit, maar toen ik ging optreden in bars was ik verkocht

Soms kom je van die platen tegen die direct indruk maken. Zoals 'Viva Rock N' Roll', het tweede album van een duo dat half Canadees (Jacob Deraps – gitaar, bas en zang) en half Australisch (Josh Gallagher – drums) is. Het is een plaat vol muzikale hoogstandjes en weergaloos gitaarspel. Aardschok zoekt contact met de naamgever van Deraps voor een nadere kennismaking.

Op je dertiende begon je met het plaatsen van video's op YouTube, maar echt serieus werd het pas rond je zeventiende.

"Ik kreeg veel aandacht in de media door de Van Halen-dingen die ik plaatste. Ik liet

m'n liefde voor die band horen, mensen vonden het leuk en begonnen het te delen. De video's werden ook opgemerkt door de Australische drummer Josh Gallagher die me benaderde en vroeg of we konden samenwerken. Het klikte meteen. Vanwege de afstand niet de makkelijkste manier van samenwerken, maar het werkte prima. Ik kon in Canada niemand vinden met het geluid en de bekwaamheden die ik zocht. Josh is een geweldige drummer en entertainer, en hij kan zingen. Onze stemmen passen perfect bij elkaar en we kunnen elkaar moeiteloos afwisselen. Je kunt wel een drummer vinden, maar dan heb je nog geen zanger en omgekeerd. Josh is beide. Hoe schrijven jullie je nummers?

"Ik neem demo's op met elektronische drums en laat ruimte voor de solosecties, coupletten en refrein en stuur dat vervolgens naar Josh. Hij komt dan terug met teksten en zang. Dat arrangeer ik dan opnieuw, net zolang tot een nummer klaar is. Zo schrijven we de meeste nummers. Het is niet perfect, maar telkens overvliegen is hartstikke duur,'

Jullie titelloze debuutalbum uit 2022 stond vooral bol van de Van Halen-invloeden. Nu is er 'Viva Rock N' Roll' waarop jullie al meer een eigen stijl ontwikkelen. Weliswaar nog steeds met Van Halen-invloeden, maar er zijn ook uitstapjes naar blues, funk en rechttoe rechtaan rock à la AC/DC en Rose Tattoo...

"De tweede plaat is inderdaad veel beter dan de eerste. De teksten zijn beter en er is meer variatie tussen de nummers. Daar denk je niet bij na, dat gebeurt gewoon. Als ik

gelijkbaar, maar de zang is anders en de manier waarop ik een deel van de solo benader ook.

Jullie kunnen allebei goed zingen. Leidt dit nooit tot strijd? "Nee, nooit. Het hangt van het bereik af wie wat zingt. Josh heeft een ander bereik dan ik, heel hoog en heel laag. Ik zit meer in het middengebied. Het hoge à la Brian Johnson of Axl Rose is voor mij moeilijk, dus dat is voor Josh. En onze samenzang is spectaculair al zeg ik het zelf, haha."

Net als op het debuutalbum heb je ook op 'Viva Rock N' Roll' de baspartijen voor je

rekening genomen' Hoe doe je dat live? "Voor optre-



we een bassist mee. Op plaat zijn het echter alleen Josh en ik die je hoort. Ik wil graag volledige controle over de muziek hebben. Het is makkelijker om het zelf te spelen

dan aan iemand anders uit te leggen wat ik bedoel.

Gaan we Deraps in deze contreien zien optreden?

"Laten we eerst maar eens kijken hoe het album het doet. We hebben in 2023 een paar shows in Groot-Brittannië gespeeld, maar dat heeft ons een hoop geld gekost. We willen heel graag en we hoeven er niets aan te verdienen, maar het moet niet weer geld gaan kosten."



Es lebe der Rock'n'Roll

★ Mit dem 2022 erschienenen und selbst betitelten Debüt konnte das Rock-Duo DERAPS, bestehend aus dem Kanadier JACOB DERAPS (Gesang, Gitarre) und dem Australier Joshua Gallagher (Gesang, Schlagzeug), erste internationale Erfolge feiern. Mit dem neuen Werk »Viva Rock n' Roll« möchte man jetzt daran anknüpfen.

Jacob, eure Musik ist maßgeblich vom Sound der 70er- und frühen 80er-Jahre beeinflusst. Woher kommt die Liebe für diese Zeit?

Mit dieser Musik bin ich aufgewachsen. Van Halen, Toto, Michael Jackson, Ozzy, Whitesnake, Stevie Ray Vaughan - all diese Bands: Das ist der Soundtrack meiner Kindheit. An der heutigen Musik gibt es nichts, was mich wirklich begeistert. Ich liebe einen organischen und natürlichen Sound. Ich mag es, wenn eine Band wie eine Band klingt und ein Schlagzeug wie ein Schlagzeug. Mit diesem komprimierten und überproduzierten Sound heutzutage kann ich nichts anfangen.

Wie herausfordernd war die Arbeit am neuen Album, nachdem euer Debüt so großartig ankam?

Eigentlich war es für uns sogar einfacher. Wir haben an den Songs gearbeitet, während wir 2023 auf Tour waren, und Josh demnach auch hier war. Vieles stammte dabei von alten Demos, die ich mit sechzehn aufgenommen habe. 'Last Fall' und 'Setting Sun' gehören da dazu - wahrscheinlich zwei meiner ersten vier oder fünf Songs überhaupt. Damals gab es noch keine Texte, diese stammen von Josh. Wir wussten, wie viel Arbeit in unser Debüt geflossen war und konnten diese Erfahrungen jetzt nutzen. Für mich war es dann aber trotzdem herausfordernd, weil ich auch das Mixing und die Produktion übernommen habe. Da musste ich viel experimentieren. Aber es ist genau so geworden, wie ich es haben wollte und darüber bin ich wirklich glücklich. Es hat viel Spaß gemacht, daran zu basteln und zu sehen, wie das Album Gestalt annimmt. Ich finde, es ist viel besser als unser Debüt.

Du bist ein großer Van Halen-Fan, deshalb noch die Fragen aller Fragen: David Lee Roth oder Sammy Hagar?

Sammy Hagar besitzt eine typische Rock-Stimme, wie man sie häufiger hört. Aber David Lee Roth ist einzigartiger. Seine Stimme hat mehr Charakter und mehr Facetten. Zudem schreibt er sehr poetische, außergewöhnliche Texte. Er hat seinen eigenen Stil und genau das macht für mich den Reiz aus. Ich denke, das ist es auch, was Van Halen mit den ersten sechs Alben so legendär gemacht hat.

acob Deraps weiß, dass es einigermaßen schwer ist, über ihn und die Musik seiner Band zu sprechen, ohne das Thema Van Halen anzuschneiden. Bekannt wurde der 1997 in St. Georges, Quebec geborene Gitarrist über seinen Youtube-Kanal. Den speiste er vor elf Jahren mit Videos seiner jugendlichen Darbietungen diverser Songs von Ratt, Ozzy Osbourne und eben Van Halen und ließ an seiner Ton- und Sound-Suche mit verschiedenen Gitarren und Verstärkern teilhaben — wie auch an Konzertmitschnitten seiner mit Schlagzeuger Josh Gallagher gestarteten Band Deraps.

»Ich habe überhaupt kein Problem damit«, so Deraps, der als Knirps vom Computerspiel Guitar Hero zur richtigen Gitarre wechselte und immer tiefer in die Musik der Gang aus Pasadena eintauchte. »Ich liebe Van Halen, das werde ich bestimmt

nicht verstecken. Für mich sind sie in der frühen Besetzung mit David Lee Roth einfach die beste Rock-Band aller Zeiten: Roh, wild, energetisch, live — so muss für mich Rock'n'Roll sein. Eddie hatte damals den besten Gitarrensound überhaupt. Er ist so organisch und natürlich verzerrt, warm, satt, aggressiv, druckvoll, hell und

sauber zugleich. Es ist ein perfekter Sound, der unglaublich angenehm für die Ohren ist und ein gutes Gefühl vermittelt.«

Es ist ein Sound, dessen Sezieren und authentisches Reproduzieren zu einer Disziplin der Wissenschaft geworden ist, die Gitarren-Nerds in aller Welt beschäftigt. So auch Jacob Deraps: Auf dem Debüt seiner nach ihm benannten Band mischten sich zwar auch Reminiszenzen an die frühen Triumph unter, die betriebsame und nur wenig subtile Gitarrenarbeit hingegen kannte in Sound und Energielevel allerdings nur ein Idol. Drei Jahre später folgt nun Viva Rock N' Roll, auf dem es bunter, reflektierter, im Sound saftiger und überhaupt auch leidenschaftlicher zugeht. Die ersten drei Stücke der Scheibe halten zumindest durch die fabelhaft in Ton und Spiel eingefangene Gitarrenarbeit bei Laune. Dann ziehen plötz-

lich auch die Lieder nach, die verdeutlichen, wie massiv Deraps im Vergleich zu ihrem Debüt qualitativ zugelegt haben. ›Last Fallk lässt ›Dance The Night Away‹ und White Lion miteinander verschmelzen und einen fabelhaften Song entstehen.

»Dieser Song stammt noch aus meinen Teenager-Tagen«, schmunzelt der Kanadier. »Wir haben uns sehr viel Zeit für die Ausarbeitung der Arrangements und Gesangsmelodien gelassen, was ihm sehr gut getan hat. Ich bin überzeugt davon, dass sich auf Viva Rock N' Roll auch andere Einflüsse heraushören lassen als Van Halen — ›Last Falk ist ein ganz gutes Beispiel.«

Auch im überraschend düsteren Hardrocker ›Born To Die‹ ist das der Fall, obgleich subtiler und zu eigenem Stil verwoben: Im Solo-Teil sind Lehrmeister wie Randy Rhoads und sogar Megadeth zu entdecken. In ›Setting Sun‹ klingen in den Chören Queen- und Styx-Referenzen an, ehe sich im Solo-Part das große Guns N' Roses-Opulenz-Drama auszubreiten beginnt. In ›Blindside‹ lassen sich Dreaps mit schmatzenden Gitarren dann tief in den Hardrock der Siebziger zurückfallen und zeigen bei alledem doch ein eigenes Gesicht.

»Wir haben sehr viel dazu gelernt nach der ersten Platte, die komplett im Trial-and-Error-Prinzip entstand«, erklärt der Gitarrist. »Wir machen wirklich alles selber: Im Studio bin ich Sänger, Gitarrist, Bassist, Produzent, Tontechniker, Arrangeur und Co-Autor mit Josh, der auch singt, Schlagzeug spielt, den Schnitt für unsere offiziellen Videos erledigt und unsere erste Platte auch noch gemischt hat. Heute blicken wir besser durch und haben noch viel mehr Spaß an dem, was wir tun!«

QC, Canada, we find rockers DERAPS. They have an excellent new eleven track album out now called 'Viva Rock N' Roll' which clocks in at around forty-right minutes long and is the duo's sophomore full length release. Since forming, the band have toured with the likes of Lee Aaron Loverboy, Ann Wilson, Foreigner, and Tom Cochrane etc... They even made it over to the UK opening for Blue Öyster Cult at the Stonedead Festival, as well as getting coverage on the Van Halen newsite. And as Van Halen have been my fave band forever, I just had to check them out, and oh my word, this is my bag right away.

'Viva Rock N' Roll' is a catchy fun high octane rocker, which smacks a punch right in your chops. The track hits hard with that classic Van Halen vibe. Singer, guitarist, and bassist Jacob Deraps channels his inner Eddie Van Halen with outstanding playing both guitar and bass wise. Vocally he is right up there belting out like David Lee Roth with high powerful killer vocals. Drummer Josh Gallagher is also outstanding, hitting his kit with all his might and again catching that VH vibe, the guys even manage to get those background style Michael Anthony vocals in, this is shit hot stuff and just reminds me how much I miss Eddie, and all the thrills of Van Halen. The band strut their 'Animal Eyes', its catchy as hell with fabulous high energy musicianship. 'The Legend of Larrikin Laddle' kicks off with fabulous bass and drums grooves, which come at you full frontal classic Led Zeppelin jamming with Whitesnake and Van Halen, this is fun rocker with killer hooks, vocals and playing. 'Equinox' is a short

instrumental melodic guitar piece with that 'Little Guitars' texture. This cascades into 'Last Fall'. this track flows with a catchier fun melodic rock vibe, slick simple and fun, with hints of 'Dance The Night Away' influences. The high energy 'Solitaire' is my favourite track, its vibrant and melodic with that classic Van Halen vibe with a slight edge Gun's N' Roses Axl vocal texture. This track is dead catchy, slick with solid crisp classy fast guitar riffs, it's really hard to think that this band are a duo. 'Setting Sun' is the longest track on the album at over six minutes long, it captures the essence of the Sammy Hagar era VH instrumental 316', however this is not an instrumental this is a deep smooth melodic track with outstanding musicianship and huge vocals, coupled with solid drumming. This is quite melodic, think along the lines of 'Take Me Back (Déjà Vu)' feel. The stomping 'Born to Die' will have VH fans salivating at the mouth, as this track is easily influenced by the first VH album with killer playing from all. This is fast based and catchy, however there also some Mötley Crüe influences coming out, punchy fun hard rock with a slight melodic texture. 'Blindside' is slick and

groove based with a solid blues rock vibe, for this reason is standout as one of the best songs on the album, big chunky guitar riffs with solid bass swagger and drum grooves with Jacob sounding amazing vocally, The groove carries over into the up-tempo 'The Dawg Stomp' which again is catchy with excellent guitar playing, while the drumming from Josh is outstanding and this song

has a southern strutting rock n roll boogie edge. Black Sheep Boogie', goes for that 'Take Your Whiskey Home' right down to the vocals, its more boogie based fun up-tempo hard rock with killer blues based guitar work and grooves, same feel, it could even have been on David Lee Roth's underrated 'A Little Ain't Enough' album with slights resemblances to 'Sensible Shoes', that type of groove, this song smokes.



 $oldsymbol{L}_{ ext{t's}}$ a Thursday evening at the moment, and main man Jacob Deraps is enjoying the summer in Québec. Canada. He is in his music room inside his apartment, where he does all of his YouTube videos, it's a small room that contains a lot of cool music gear. As a band Deraps are a classic sounding rock band, influenced by all kinds of music genres of the 70's and 80's. They touch many different styles, Blues, Pop Rock, Hard Rock, Heavy Metal, all with a consistent sound, like Van Halen or Led Zeppelin used to do, for example. "Our music is very organic, with a good balance of raw and polished. We use actual live drums (no samples), catchy, groovy guitar riffs

and hooks at its forefront. big solos, and huge vocal harmonies. We don't like the typical sampled, quantized, over polished, brick- walled sound that we hear all the time these days in modern rock and metal music," he expresses. He grew up in a family of musicians. his mom has a bachelor in Jazz saxophone, she also plays Classical piano and bass, and my dad plays guitar and bass. "They don't do it professionally but that was always their passion," he points out. When he was young, there was always great music surrounding him, in the car, in the house, band rehearsals, mom playing Mozart on piano, with his dad playing Van Halen on guitar, etc... His parents bought him a drum kit when he was four years old. "I played a bit and had a great sense of rhythm. I remember playing Stone Temple Pilots but I was just too young to care and really get into it back then so they ended up selling it at some point," he tells me. "When he was twelve, he was playing the Guitar Hero and Rock Band video games a lot, and that's what made me want to really learn the guitar. "I loved all the Classic Rock music that was on those games. I picked up my dad's 1989 blue HM Strat, learned all my basic chords in an evening and started learning pieces of music, and that's how it all started," he enthuses. Van Halen is the bands biggest influence, as you can hear in songs like 'Animal Eyes' and 'Last Fall', but there are tons of other influences on the album. For example, 'The Legend of Larrikin Laddie' is their tribute to Bon Scott and is very much influenced by early AC/DC, songs like 'Let There Be

Rock' and 'Whole Lotta

Rosie.' Another example is the song 'Setting Sun', this one has some Toto mixed with Axl Rose style vocals, coupled with a Randy Rhoads influenced outro solo, some Guns N' Roses, some Van Halen, etc...



"The song 'Blindside' shows my Blues influences, a bit of Stevie Ray Vaughan and Joe Bonamassa, there's also a bit of early Eagles in the vocal harmonies and the outro solo, which I'm a huge fan of. There are others too, Born to Die, Solitaire, Black Sheep Boogie... All songs that sound completely different from each other and have a unique flavour and influence," he expresses. Outside of music Jacob is into F1 racing. "I got to visit the Silverstone museum and circuit on our mini UK tour, in 2023. There was a Ferrari doing laps while we were there, that was cool to see! I do a bit of sim racing and gaming; I like playing poker with my buddies also... I love hanging out with friends, playing acoustic guitar, and drinking microbrew beers on a good summer night, those are my kind of moments! Or spending time with my family, simple, fun stuff," he smiles. 'Viva Rock N' Roll' is a trip back to the greatest years of music, when albums had

an organic sound and feel. when bands wrote what they loved and meant without sticking to a premade formula. "It sounds raw, live and polished at the same time, it's authentic and creative, nostalgic and fresh," he says with spirit. The new album is a natural evolution from the band's debut album, in the same style but a lot more mature in every way. For example the songwriting, the performances and the production are all much better. "We also had a lot more fun to do this one than the first one because we knew what we wanted and had gained the experience to get there. The first one was a real struggle, we were basically learning on the job, doing countless trial and error, and working with lesser gear and knowledge. The new one, everything just kind of fell into place, naturally. Of course, it wasn't without any struggle, I had to learn a few things on the job while I was mixing but I actually enjoyed doing it, and I'm proud of it," he says with a sense of satisfaction. The drums and electric guitars were recorded in his ex-girlfriend's father's garage. "There's a big office inside the garage and that's where we did it. Then, I did the bass, vocals, and acoustic guitars in my small studio room, in my apartment. Josh also recorded some vocals in Australia, believe it or not, he did it in his car. We do everything that we can, with what we have," he smiles. Finally, Jacob produced and mixed everything himself, in his studio room. "Then, we went to the mastering and my ex Élizabeth hand drew the artwork cover, she did an incredible job with so

eggs in there. The whole album took a bit over a year to finish." It is really hard for the musician to select an album highlight. "I'm gonna go with 'Setting Sun.' It's a massive production, it sounds incredible and has so many of our favourite influences. I think it has it all, the lyrics are deep and meaningful, the music is super catchy and melodic from the start, it's packed with dynamics, highs, and lows, it takes you on a ride like a roller coaster. It also has so many layers of instruments and vocals, a lot of very important details. It's some of our most creative, complete, and emotional work," he expresses. The band haven't toured in a while but they have started booking a 2026 headlining tour, which is their first time headlining venues, and they are dead excited. "It would be great to also score a few big opening spots, like we did in 2023, with Foreigner in Toronto. We're also looking into doing a first step in the US very soon, we want to grow a bigger audience and be able to do more consistent touring."



Everything is possible and Deraps are determined to push and reach beyond their biggest goals and dreams. "More albums, more tours, headlining bigger stages, we love what we do and we want to be able to do it all the time for a very long time," concludes Jacob, bringing an end to our conversation.





Next on stage we have the band I've been most looking forward to. A new band for a good majority here no doubt. They are 'DERAPS' hailing from Canada. They've been making quite a name for themselves as Jacob Deraps, has been setting YouTube on fire with his Van Halen guitar videos. He then added Australian drummer, Josh Gallagher to the line up and went on the road. With the release of the first album entitled 'DERAPS' the band took on a Bass player, today Thaddy Lavoie has that honour. The guitar and drums are very Alex and Eddie. In fact, so good are the band that the debut album is sold in the official Van Halen shop. A feat achieved by no one else. 'Make Ya Groove' is slightly down in tempo but a crazy solo lets you know there is more to come. A brief bass solo from Thaddy Lavoie takes us into 'Live Fast Die Slow' which kicks off with some nice double stops and a solid rhythm section. The walking beat soon gives way to Jacob and his screaming guitar. This young band are setting the bar, that's for sure. Gotta have a drum solo thrown in a set and DERAPS don't disappoint with a hammering of the kit supported by the hey's from the crowd. fast feet and plenty of crash cymbals make way for 'Wild to the Woman' with cowbell! You can never have too much cowbell!

Distorted guitar sizzles and Jacob sings along proving he has a voice to match his playing. Speaking of which he now takes the stage with an acrobatic feat of guitar playing worthy of the great man himself. I guess when your back catalog consists of playing VH tracks there is always going to be the comparison whilst you build a career. 'Fuck Off' follows with its high-speed drumming and faster guitar riffing before we go into 'Highway Star' the inevitable Van Halen cover with 'Hot for Teacher' and its stunning drum beat and finally finishing the set with 'Ballroom Blitz' by the Sweet. Oh! and let's not forget the Rocket Queens dance troupe. This awesome quintet of girls danced their hearts out with the boys for the last song of the set. At one point forming a line for Jacob to play off of. A great moment provided by this podium dancing troupe resulting in a phenomenal, stand out set... Stonedead is finished for another year. Yet again, Chris, Louise and Neil have put on another belter of a day. There has been a good spread of bands, the obvious stand out for me being DERAPS, a band I've watched on YouTube for a while and have finally gotten to enjoy a stunning live set.

The flamboyant Jacob Deraps, a young guitar hero from Beauce (Quebec) whom I had already seen at the Imperial Bell in Quebec as the opening act for the group Sword, arrives on stage at 6:30 p.m. Deraps is a force in the making in the hard-rock world. Inspired by the music of the late 1970s and especially by the late guitarist Eddie Van Halen, Deraps signed an agreement with the Anthem Entertainment label, the same publisher as the legendary Canadian group Rush. His dexterity on six strings is matched only by the quality of his compositions and his charisma on stage. The group gives their all on stage, high-energy from beginning to end. Australian Josh Gallagher, drummer of the group, will have his lion's share by performing a powerful drum solo to go to Hot for Teacher, cover of the favorite group Van Halen. Ballroom Blitz, their own spin of Sweet classic, which appears on the eponymous first album, puts an end to this short 30-minute performance.

DERAPS SET THE BAR WAY TOO HIGH: I have to confess that although I was excited at the prospect of seeing Lee Aaron, Coney Hatch and Sven Gali playing from the same stage in one night, Day Two of the Sound of Music Festival became a "must attend" event when Deraps were added to the line-up for that night. Who in the heck are Deraps you might ask? Well, they happen to be the hottest new band to come out of Canada. I use the term "to come out of Canada" loosely as drummer Josh Gallagher is actually based in Perth, Australia of all places but hell, this band is so good that I am going to always consider them a "Canadian" group. To be fair, I believe that all or most of Deraps' gigs to date have been on Canadian soil although they are scheduled to play the Stonehead Festival in the UK on August 26, 2023.

In any case, Deraps released their debut self-titled album last year and I placed it at #7 on the Sleaze Roxx's Top Ten Albums of 2022. So yeah, I was really pumped to see Deraps play live because for the most part, they have been playing all over the place in the province of Quebec (with the city of Montreal being about a five hour drive from Toronto).... (Deraps drummer) Gallagher was the first to greet the Burlington crowd from behind his drum kit.

The man had a huge grin that never left his face for the rest of Deraps' set. The three Deraps band members launched into their track "Sex, Drugs & Rock N' Roll' and we were off to the races. Just from that one song, it felt like you were seeing something special on stage with Gallagher and the Cliff Burton lookalike bassist laying down a very solid Van Halen-ish groove which allowed Jacob Deraps the chance to absolutely shine on guitar. I've always found that the truly great guitarists can almost talk with their guitar and that's what it felt like when Jacob was playing ... Although there is no question that Jacob Deraps is a true guitar virtuoso, he also handled the lead vocals on most of the songs. The vocal harmonies between him and Gallagher were so good. Gallagher's harmony vocals reminded me of the terrific harmony vocals that Van Halen had when both bassist Michael Anthony and guitarist Eddie Van Halen were in the lineup. I didn't realize this when listening to Deraps' debut self-titled album but Gallagher also handles some of the lead vocal duties since he sang most of the lead vocals on the third track played by Deraps at the Sound of Music Festival — the very groovy "Make Ya Groove." Just like Van Halen, Deraps aren't limited to just one style of music as their set had a bit of everything from the back burning scorchers like "Sex,

Drugs & Rock N' Roll" and "Fuck Off" to the ballad "On My Mind" to the easy to sing along to "My Side of Town" to the groove based party track "Make Ya Groove."...their new bassist is Thaddy Lavoie, and let's just say that the man has the skills and the chops to hang in there with two of the most talented young musicians you'll get to hear in Jacob Deraps and Josh Gallagher. Speaking of Jacob Deraps, I can't say enough about just how good of a guitarist that he is. He possesses that same "it" quality that Eddie Van Halen had... I was really BLOWN AWAY by Deraps' performance. They were so good!

I didn't want them to stop. Deraps set the bar way too high for any band to follow them and although Sven Gali, Coney Hatch and Lee Aaron understandably had bigger followings and bigger crowds watching them, Deraps truly stole the show on this night. I think that where the biggest discrepancy between Deraps and the other bands was when it came to the guitar solos. There was simply no following Jacob Deraps in that regard and any solo from guitarists Andy Frank (Sven Gali), Sean Williamson (Sven Gali) and Sean Kelly (Coney Hatch, Lee Aaron) simply paled in comparison to what Jacob Deraps had previously played. Jacob Deraps was simply at a way higher level guitar playing wise."

Deraps: Sunset-Strip-in-Québec! It was up to the young Quebec hard rock band Deraps to warm up an already crowded room while waiting for the headliners to arrive on stage. "Heating up" would be a big word here in this circumstance, because the enthusiasm of the spectators present had already reached a maximum level of excitement which did not diminish one iota throughout the evening, As these avowed disciples of Van Halen and Californian rock of the 70s and 80s rose to the occasion with flying colors, from the first incandescent "hammer-ons" of Jacob with both hands on the neck of his instrument during Invasion, the short solo which opened their performance. And ten seconds after attacking the following song Sex, Drugs & Rock'n'Roll, taken from their first eponymous album with its riff and rhythm reminiscent of I'm The One or Hot for Teacher, the "guitar whiz" group had already put the public in his back pocket!

Contagious energy and good humor, no downtime, catchy songs, complicity and pure pleasure of playing are their strengths, and I want to highlight this unique chemistry between Jacob and the exuberant Josh in terms of vocals, a dynamic that reminded me at times of that between their counterparts Mark Farner

and Don Brewer within Grand Funk Railroad more than half a century ago (by the way, young people, check out on YouTube Inside Looking Out by Grand Funk Railroad in concert, 1969... Brilliant!). In short, an action-packed half-hour of invigorating and festive music which ended with a supercharged cover of Sweet's Ballroom Blitz, which earned these young international rock hopes "made in Quebec" a well-deserved ovation from the thousand spectators present.

For the occasion, the Quebec group Deraps acted as opening act. An impressive number of fans are in the room when Jacob Deraps and his friends take the stage to offer us their classic rock style of music. Jacob is simply breathtaking on guitar and we notice that the musicians are extremely happy to be on stage. The crowd greatly appreciated their show and it would not be surprising to see them again in the metropolis in the near future.

For those not in the know, Deraps feature the team of Canadian guitar virtuoso Jacob Deraps (who also handles the lead vocals) and drummer Josh Gallagher who happens to live across the world in Perth, Australia. Deraps' line-up is rounded up by Canadian bassist William Lachance. I am not quite sure how these guys have been able to make this long distance arrangement work but Deraps' debut album is simply phenomenal. If you love old school David Lee Roth era Van Halen, you're going to absolutely (or you should) love Deraps' self-titled record.

The guitar work alone is worth the price of the album. Throw in Jacob Deraps' tongue in cheek singing, the great vocal harmonies and the swagger of the awesome rhythm section duo of Gallagher and Lachance, and you have one of the most exciting debut records in a long time, or certainly at least for 2022. Deraps offers a lot of variety from the fast paced "Sex, Drugs & Rock N' Roll" to the fury of "Fuck Off" to the '80s sounding "Veins of My Heart" to the acoustic instrumental "Élizabeth." Even my wife who hardly likes any hard rock / heavy metal tunes couldn't help but be impressed by the musicianship displayed by the Deraps' band members when I forced her to listen to the album on our drive back from Florida to Toronto (under the guise that I needed to stay awake). That's saying quite a lot right there. If you haven't already done so, make sure you check out one of the best debut albums that has come out in the last decade."

Thurseer Time Jacob Derays and Josh Gallagher shared a stage was with Toto. After the pair met through YouTube and collaborated remotely, Australian drummer Gallagher flew to guitarist/singer Derays's Canadian home town in the summer of 2017. Local bar shows, festivals and private parties beckoned. First, though, they had tickets to see Steve Lukather and co. — preceded by a meet-and-greet that surpassed their wildest dreams.

"That was really insane," 25-year-old Deraps enthuses. "We asked if we could come up and do a song with them, on their sound-check, and they agreed and we played Rosana. It was the first time me and Josh played together, but it didn't feel like the first time. There's a connection between us."

They haven't even done a proper tour yet, but Deraps could do for Van Halen what Greta Van Fleet did for Led Zeppelin – as the young punters at their first gigs have suggested. Written, recorded and produced entirely by Deraps and Gallagber, their self-titled debut doesn't so much wear its influences on its sleeve as dress head-to-toe in them. Still, with such spot-on delivery, killer nills and moreish choruses it's ferociously good fun. Single Ser. Drugs And Rock 6 Roll is like Hot For Teacher on Hambo, hard to resist.

But Doups isn't just a VH fest. The blues rock of Stevie Ray

Vaughan can be heard in Live First, Die Slow, while funky bass lines, popgloss and Metallica-corne-GNR beef pepper the rest of the record. "Van Halen has always been an obsession." Deraps concedes. "The sound, the guitar playing, the feel and the groove. But it's not a copycat thing."

Born in Quebec in 1997, Jacob Deraps grew up immersed in a wide range of music. His father played guitar in local bars, his mother played juzz saxophone, classical plano and bass. In a 21st-century twist, though, it was videogames that inspired him to pick up the guitar. Aged 11, he was

with his parents in a shopping mall when he saw a red V-shaped guitar "exactly like the one I saw in Rack Band". He begged them buy it. They compromised with an alternative model, which Deraps became hooked or: "With Guitar Herothere's a lot of songs from the seventies and eighties and I just loved that music, so when I picked up the [real] guitar I knew what I wanted to play."

At 16 he quit school to focus on music, working factory shifts and tempocary jobs on the side. He threw himself into making YouTube videos, and wound up on stage with Dweezil Zappu before meeting Gallagher and forming Derays in 2017.

To date, their gigging has been restricted by geography and Quebec's long brutal winters. Now, plans for a European tour are in the works. "We want to tour, we're ready for that." Deraps says. "And I want to be in an environment where I can not worry about anything else and make music all the time." PG




